

This chart displays all 533 Parliamentary Constituencies in England divided into deciles divided by their position on the index of multiple deprivation as listed by Parliament in 2015. The 1st decile are the most deprived constituencies, the 10th the least. There are three extra constituencies in the final decile as 533 doesn't divide perfectly into 10. The colours represent how they voted in the 2016 EU Referendum, yellow for Remain and purple for Leave. As this is based on a projection and not complete results, constituencies where the winning side won with 53% of the vote or less are given a slightly lighter shade of the relevant colour.
