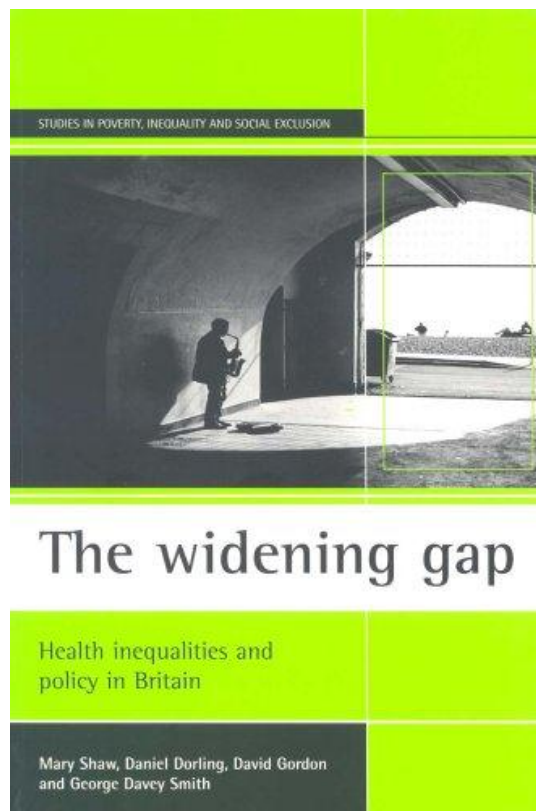


The Widening Gap: health inequalities and policy in Britain
